

1       **612:10-7-150. Continued eligibility for college or university training**  
2       **[AMENDED]**

3  
4       (a) **Requirements for continued eligibility.** DVR or DVS clients in college or  
5       university training will be expected to attend classes regularly and make  
6       continuous progress toward graduation. To continue assistance with college or  
7       university training, the client must maintain a cumulative 2.0 grade-point average  
8       (GPA), based on a four point (4.0) scale. The client must carry the minimum  
9       number of semester hours determined to be full time at the school attended.  
10      Exceptions may be granted by the home counselor, based on severity of  
11      disability, scheduling problems, or other valid reasons. When a client fails to  
12      meet the requirements for continued sponsorship the guidelines in (1) - (5) of this  
13      Subsection are to be followed:

14  
15           (1) Payment of training services based on client's financial status will not be  
16           provided if the client's grades fall below 1.5 cumulative GPA.

17  
18           (2) Services may be paid for a client having a cumulative GPA between 1.5  
19           and 1.9 for the first semester that grades fall below 2.0 cumulative GPA.  
20           Subsequent enrollments can only be paid if the student's cumulative GPA  
21           shows progress.

23           (3) A client failing to meet the grade point requirement may continue to  
24           receive services not based on financial status.

25  
26           (4) A client failing to meet grade point requirements may be approved by the  
27           ~~home~~ counselor if there are extenuating circumstances beyond the client's  
28           control.

30           (5) A client failing to meet grade point requirements will be contacted as soon  
31           as appropriate to complete a program review to determine if a change in  
32           services, vocational goal, or objectives is needed. A client failing to meet  
33           chosen goals will not have his/her case closed until the counselor has  
34           provided counseling and guidance and determined that a change in the IPE is  
35           inappropriate. The counselor should investigate the need for further  
36           vocational and/or educational evaluation to explore alternative employment  
37           goals.

39       (b) **Withdrawals and failures.** Clients who withdraw or fail courses paid by DVR  
40       and DVS will be required to pay for a like number of hours during the following  
41       enrollment period subject to the guidelines in (a) of this Section.

43       (c) **Enrollment instructions:** Each ~~consumer~~ client is responsible for providing  
44       ~~either their home counselor or supervising counselor~~ a copy of the college or  
45       university's current semester costs before the designated "Drop and Add" date.  
46       No authorization for previous semester's costs will be issued.
